## **Uniform Expectations**

As we are approaching the end of term, and many of you will be beginning to think about purchasing new uniform for your children for September, please see below for the expectations regarding uniform.

For children in Foundation up to Year 5, a red cardigan or jumper, black or grey trousers/skirt/dress, white polo shirt and sensible, sturdy, supportive, school shoes (not trainers) are required.

For children in Year 6 a black cardigan or jumper, black or grey trousers/skirt/dress, white polo shirt and sensible school shoes (not trainers) are required.

**Children are not allowed to wear nail varnish/gels or false nails of any type.**

**Jewellery must not be worn.** If earrings are worn they must be small studs and children must be able to remove them for PE. If the ears are newly pierced then parents must provide tape to cover the earrings.

All children **MUST** have a red P.E. t-shirt with the Chestnuts logo (available from the website below) with black shorts, black jumper and black tracksuit bottoms in the winter for PE lessons. Trainers or plimsoles are also required. **All jewellery must be removed for PE including earrings.**

**School shoes must be worn by all pupils. Black trainers are not acceptable.**
