

English – Reading and Writing

In reading, we will be exploring the poem the Owl and the Pussycat by Edward Lear. We will also be reading the story Mr. Majeika and the picture book The problem with Pierre.

In writing, we are writing an adventure story based on The Building Boy by Ross Montgomery. We are also going to be learning about persuasion and creating a persuasive piece of writing.

Maths

In maths, we are going to begin our measurement unit. We will explore measuring length and height using metres and centimetres, weighing in grams and kilograms and comparing these. We will also be exploring capacity and temperature. In Year 2, it is important for children to be confident in reading scales in various contexts. We will also be recapping the written methods of addition and subtraction and building our confidence in using a numberline.
