

Communication and Language

Using speech is just part of what we will be doing in Blossom. Our use of sign language and visuals mean that we can all communicate with each other. We will be playing with the sound of rhyming words and matching pictures to make new rhymes and silly rhymes.

Personal, Social and Emotional

We will continue to develop our use of the Zones of Regulation for when we feel sad, silly or angry. We will be noticing how our friends are feeling and how the characters in the nursery rhymes are feeling too. We will consider how we can make Little Miss Muffet feel happy and how we can stop Humpty Dumpty being silly on the wall so he doesn't fall off?

Literacy

In literacy, we will be reading, singing and signing nursery rhymes, focusing on the rhyming patterns and finding other words that rhyme with them.

Maths

In maths, we will be counting sheep and flowers and some children will be learning how to count in different multiples. We will also explore shapes and their properties.

Physical Development

Co-ordination will be our focus using small equipment, such as quoits and balls, to throw and catch accurately. We will also be practising different ways that we can make our body balance.

Understanding the World

Our focus on springtime and nature will be through our nursery rhymes such as Mary, Mary Quite Contrary with her garden and Little Bo Peep with her sheep. We will use this to learn about the world around us.

Expressive Arts and Design

We will be exploring different ways to paint and dye eggs in Humpty Dumpty week as well as creating spiders, lambs and flowers in our art sessions too. We will also explore the sounds of instruments, singing and dancing through nursery rhymes.
