

Communication and Language

We will continue to develop our use of sign language focusing on different flowers, creatures and plants that you might find in the garden. We will continue to develop our vocabulary and speech using role play and games about minibeasts, flowers and plants.

Personal, Social and Emotional

We will continue to develop our understanding of the zones of regulation and how they can help us when we are feeling sad, cross, or silly. We will be reading stories about different minibeasts that are exploring those feelings and how they overcome them.

Literacy

We will be reading stories and poems about different objects and creatures that you might find in the garden. We will focus on the characters and events that happen in the stories.

Maths

We will be looking at number this half term, counting, adding, subtracting and beginning multiplication and division using objects and pictures.

Physical Development

We will be using our outdoor spaces to explore how different minibeasts move and to go on different hunts for plants, trees and minibeasts. We will continue to develop strength in our hand muscles by digging to find different plants and creatures.

Understanding the World

Exploring our natural world outside is so important and will be an integral part of this topic. We will learn what is outside in the mud, on the grass, in the leaves and in the trees. We will look at different forms of life.

Expressive Arts and Design

We will be creating little dramatic productions about different minibeasts and how they move. We will also be creating musical interpretations of this and will create artistic pieces out of clay and different sculpting materials as well as paintings and colouring.
