Communication and Language
We will be using the words and the British Sign
language for different creatures and objects that we
might find on, under or by the sea. We will continue to
use the total communication approach to interact and
listen to our friends and the adults in Blossom.

Personal, Social and Emotional
Turn taking is our focus during this half term, playing
games involving pirates and under the sea creatures
such as octopuses and fish. We will continue to use
the Zones of Regulation to communicate how we are
feeling and to notice how others are feeling.

Literacy

Pirate stories will be our focus for three weeks, then moving on to under the sea creatures found in the Commotion in the Ocean poems and lastly looking at the seaside and holidays with Paddington and Topsy and Tim.

Maths

We will be consolidating our learning about how to add and subtract using pirate treasure. We will also be learning position and direction skills focusing on where different sea creatures and objects are.

Physical Development
We will be completing activities
that involve developing fine motor
control such as hole punching,

throwing, catching and balancing
using a range of equipment.

Understanding the World
We will be finding out all about
our world on, by and under the
sea. We will do some creative
cooking involving sea food and
ice cream and we hope to visit a
local garden centre beach

Expressive Arts and Design
We will be trying out lots of different
tools and techniques to make clay sea
creatures, paintings and drawings. We
will also be learning some pirate and
under the sea dances and singing lots
of sea shanties.
