English – Reading and Writing
In reading, we will be studying the fiction book
Crater Lake. We will also study a picture book – The
arrival and a poetry unit based around the poet Karl
Nova.

In writing, we will be creating our own suspense narratives and biased arguments in our non-fiction unit. We will also be learning to write and perform poetry using figurative language.

Maths

This half term in maths, we will be exploring geometry whilst consolidating and revisiting key units such as number (4 operations) and fractions, decimals and percentages.

Science

Our science learning this half term will be focused on the properties and changes of materials. We will explore the properties of a variety of materials, explore solubility and also whether reactions are reversible or irreversible. We will use our scientific enquiry skills to perform investigations.

Art and Design

This half term, we will be finding out about the artist, Faith Ringgold and her talent of creating narrative quilts. We will learn how to sew. We will focus on various stitches, how to embellish a design and how to evaluate the products we make.
