

Speaking, Listening and Communication

We will be learning the basic sign language for our fairy tales, but also the basic signs that we will need in our daily lives. We will continue to use role play and repetition of our stories to act out different character roles, our favourite being The Big Bad Wolf!

English

Reading fairy tales is one of our favourite activities that we revisit every year. We love retelling the repeated parts of the story using words, signs and visuals. We will continue to develop mark making and word writing in our role plays and through writing about what we can see in the stories.

Maths

Depending on where we are in our learning journey, counting and basic addition and subtraction will be our focus for this half term. We will use resources to help us sort and recognise differences between different counting objects from our fairy tale stories.

Physical Education and Development

This half term, we will be focusing on our awareness of the people and space around us when we move around the hall and outdoor areas. We will also be completing our daily fine motor activities such as hole punching, threading and dotting fairy tale characters.

Blossom Topic 1

P.S.H.E.

This half term, we will be revisiting The Zones of Regulation to help us recognize how we are feeling. We will learn how to communicate feelings and emotions, including the way characters are feeling and acting in stories. We will have reminders for how we behave at school and will notice what makes us happy at school.

Scientific Technologies

We will be investigating materials this half term considering how we can make Baby Bear's chair stronger or which materials are best to build a new house for the Three Little Pigs. We will be sorting objects into the different materials they are made from and will explore the differences between materials using all of our senses.

Humanities

Our focus this half term will be on learning about our families and our local area, including the classroom, the school and the field. We hope to visit some of the areas close to our school such as the playground to find out what is local to us.

The Arts

We will investigate different tools and techniques in art to create different representations of fairy tale characters. We will also experiment with clay and making 3D sculptures using junk modelling. In music, we will be listening to different songs related to fairy tales and will learn to move rhythmically to music.
