English – Reading and Writing
In reading, we will be looking at Paddington,
exploring Roald Dahl's Revolting Rhymes and
also looking at a non-fiction text about David
Attenborough from the Little People, Big Planet
series.

In writing, we will be creating an adventure narrative based on the story The Secret of Black Rock. We will also write a non-chronological report about homes and houses. We will end the term exploring riddles to develop our understanding of poetry.

Maths

At the start of this term, we will be looking at statistics using pictograms, tables and bar charts. We will then move on to understanding place value of numbers in the hundreds and thousands. Pupils will learn how to order and compare numbers based on their place value. Finally, we will look at addition and subtraction using number lines and dienes as concrete resources. Children will then explore the links between concrete, pictorial and abstract methods of calculation.

Science


This term in science, we will be looking at how rocks are formed. We will be classifying rocks based on their properties. We will perform some investigations looking at how dense, porous and durable different rock types are. We will also be discovering how soil is formed and the essential elements in the different types of soil we have locally.

History

In history, we will be exploring the Stone Age. We will be discovering what life was like in this time period. We will look at places of significance, for example Stonehenge, Skara Brae and Starr Carr. We will also be learning about the tools that they made for hunting and gathering.

Art and Design

In art and design this term, we will be extending our knowledge of weaving that we learnt in Year 1. We will start with using a basic weaving frame and then explore how to create a 3D woven structure using different types of yarns.



Design and Technology

This term in design and technology, we will be learning about where our food comes from and why the seasons are important for crops in the UK. We will explore different seasonal vegetables and create our own healthy stew.

R.E.

Through our R.E. lessons this half term, we will be exploring Hinduism. We will focus on how Hindus worship at home and at the mandir.

P.S.H.E.

This term in Jigsaw, we will be understanding how we can make sensible choices and learning that we are all unique. We will be looking at how our actions can impact others inside and outside of school.

P.E.

In our gymnastics lessons, we will be extending our knowledge of different jumps, rolls and balances. We will also be taking part in invasion sports and starting to explore how to throw and catch a ball, move around a court and play a sport where rules are involved.

Music

Through music lessons, we will be beginning to understand musical language. We will be listening to and evaluating different pieces of music. We will also learn to perform them on the recorder or through singing.

In German lessons, we will be finding out where Germany is geographically. We will also learn basic greetings and how to share our feelings before learning how to read, write and say numbers in German.
