English – Reading and Writing
In reading, we will be starting a new fiction text called
'Oliver Moon and the Potion Commotion'. We will
also study a non-fiction text called 'Animal Magic' and
a poem called 'Three Little Leaves'.
In writing, we will be writing a portal narrative. We
will also write an instructional text based on
the story 'Monstersaurus'. During our poetry week,
we will be looking at shape poetry.

Maths

In maths this half term, we will be looking at addition and subtraction of 1-digit numbers and 2-digit numbers. We will think about the methods that we use to do this and we will also be using a range of concrete materials and numberlines to help us in our learning.

History

In our history topic, we will be exploring the history of our local area. Our learning will focus on the history of Bletchley Park and the impact of its work and discoveries on World War II. We will be researching Alan Turing and looking at how he contributed too.

Computing

In computing, we will be looking at the term 'data' and understanding what this means.

We will also think about how data can be collected in the form of a tally chart. We will then move onto presenting data in the form of pictograms and finally block diagrams. We will use the data presented to answer questions.

Year 2 Topic 2

Design and Technology

This half term in design and technology, we will be looking at cooking and nutrition. We will be looking at healthy foods and hidden sugars. Taking all of this into consideration, we will be designing and making our own healthy wraps.

R.E.

In R.E. this half term, we are continuing to explore Judaism. We will be focusing on the Jewish celebration of Hannukah, learning what it is and how Jewish people celebrate it.

P.S.H.E.

Our Jigsaw topic this half term is 'Celebrating Difference'. We will be learning how people can be different and how these differences make us unique and special. We will also discuss the differences between right and wrong and what to do if we feel like we are being bullied.

P.E.

In our dance lessons, we will be learning how to dance in different formations and move to the rhythm of the music on our own and as a duet.

In our physical literacy lessons, we will be looking at how to move with a ball and pass with control.

Music

Our music topic this half term is called 'Ho, Ho, Ho'. We will learn the rap, find the pulse of the music and use the glockenspiels and recorders to compose and improvise.
