English – Reading and Writing

In phonics lessons, we will continue to work on our speed and fluency of reading.

In writing, we will be creating our own adventure stories based on the book 'The Queen's Hat'. We will also be writing our own report of a recent experience.

Maths

In maths, we will focus on number knowledge. We will consolidate our understanding of place value to 20 and extend this to working with numbers to 50. We will continue to complete addition and subtraction calculations, now working with both one- and two-digit numbers.

Science

In our science lessons, we will be learning to name different animals and animal groups. When learning about humans, we will name body parts and think about which body parts link to different senses.

Geography

In geography lessons, we will be learning about how the weather differs across the seasons. We will also learn about hot and cold places on Earth and where they are in relation to the Equator, North Pole and South Pole.

Art

In art and design lessons, we will be exploring how to apply different amounts of pressure when sketching with a pencil to create different marks. We will also be making close observation of facial features and be practicing sketching these using a different range of marks.



Computing

Through our computing lessons, we will begin to learn how to sort and use data and information. We will begin by using labels to put objects into groups. We will then demonstrate how we can sort objects into different groups, based on properties we choose. We will also answer questions on our data groups.

R.E.

In our R.E. lessons, we will continue to learn about Christian beliefs, why the Bible is important to Christians and about different stories that Jesus told.

P.S.H.E.

Our P.S.H.E. topic of 'Dreams and Goals' will allow us to explore our goals for the future, think about how we can achieve them and what to do when we come across

challenges.

P.E.

Through our P.E. lessons, we will participate in team games, developing simple tactics for attacking and defending. We will also continue to develop our ball skills, practicing passing a ball to other players on our team.

Music

In our music lessons, we will be learning the song 'In the Groove'. We will also be finding the pulse to the baroque style of music and using glockenspiels to recreate notes from the song.
