Speaking, Listening and Communication This half term, we will be practising making new sounds, saying new words and repeated sentences in our patterned stories. We will also be learning new British Sign Language signs for words such as grass, park, shark and bear. We will talk in our role plays such as a bear cave and using small world park equipment. English During our English learning, we will be reading stories with patterns in them such as 'We're Going on a Bear Hunt' and 'Shark in the Park', joining in with the rhythms and rhymes. Some of us will be mark making with different implements whilst others of us will be writing words and sentences about the stories.

Topic 4

Maths

In maths, we will be learning about numbers and counting. Some of us will be progressing on to early multiplication and division skills using objects from the stories to help us.

P.S.H.E.

In Blossom, we are all now able to put our picture card on a Zone of Regulation to show how we are feeling in the mornings. Some of us use the zones to help us when we are unregulated. We will continue to talk about and communicate our feelings. We will also be talking about healthy teeth and visiting the dentist.

The Arts

In art, we will be exploring different media to create the different animals that we will learn about in our stories. Some of us will explore how to express our feelings in art. In music, we will play instruments in different ways such as slowly, quietly and loudly. We will learn songs and move rhythmically to music.

Physical Education

In our P.E. lessons, we will continue to learn how to move in, on, under and through the large equipment with accuracy. We will be moving like the animals and creatures from our patterned stories.

Scientific Technologies Our science learning is based in our outdoor area. We will notice changes in the season for spring arriving and we will look at different objects and creatures that we can find outside. In computing, we will be using iPads to take photos and we will be completing activities on screen.

Humanities During our history learning, we will be looking at our own past, thinking about what we looked like and did when we were younger. In geography, we will be looking at our local area, walking around the school to find out where different places are. Some of us will begin to look at maps and notice the basic symbols we use.
