English – Reading and Writing
In reading, we will be studying the
fiction book, Oranges in No Man's Land.
This will be followed by a non-fiction
text on the Anglo-Saxons. At the end of
the term, we will focus on a poem by
Benjamin Zephaniah called Good Hope.
In writing, we will be creating our own
myths and legends and learning how to
write newspaper reports.

#### Maths

Through out maths learning this half term, we will be continuing to develop our understanding of measurement and revisiting our learning around fractions, decimals and percentages. We will then move on to learning about shapes and how to find their perimeters, areas and volumes.

## Science

This half term we will be focusing on living things and their habitats. We will research the life cycles of a variety of animals and compare the similarities and differences between them. We will also look at how plants and animals reproduction.

# Geography

During our geography lessons, we will be learning about the physical and human features of Mexico. We will be comparing these to the other areas of the world that we have learnt about previously.

# Art and Design

In art and design, we will be learning how to sketch using sketching pencils. We will learn a range of different techniques to add shading to our work. We will also discover the work of David Hockney and learn about the techniques he used to create his paintings.

# Computing

This half term in computing, we will be looking at how flat-file database can be used in records. We will use tools within a database to order and answer questions about data.

# R.E.

This term, our focus will be on Christianity and the way in which Christians live their lives. We will explore their daily practices and how they contribute to the community.
