English – Reading and Writing In reading, some of us will be reading Dilly the Dinosaur and Hamilton's Hat. Others of us will be reading Polly Flint and studying the poem Macavity The Mysterious Cat. Some of us will also continue to develop our phonic knowledge, working on our set 2 and 3 sounds.

In writing, some of us will be writing traditional tales and instructions while others of us will be writing a journey narrative and a diary entry.

Maths

In our maths learning, we will have a focus on calculation with some of us learning to add and subtract and some of us mulitplying and dividing. We will also complete some work on measures, including learning about fractions, length, height, mass, capacity, temperature and perimeter.

Science

During our science lessons, we will be identifying and describing the functions of the parts of a plant. We will explore the life cycle of a flowering plant and look at how water is transported within a plant. We will also gain an understanding of how seeds are dispersed and the requirements of plants for life and growth.

History

This half term, we will be concluding our exploration of the prehistoric period by looking at the Iron Age. we will be learning how housing and farming changed during this period. We will also explore the art and culture of the period with a focus on Celtic knots and how they were used as a decorative source for jewelry and other artefacts.

Art and Design

In our art and design lessons, we will be looking at how Van Gogh used colour and paint techniques to create The Starry Night. We will recap our colour mixing techniques and extend our learning about bush techniques in order to apply these to our own pieces.

R.E.

In R.E. this topic, we will be looking at Islam and explaining how Muslims worship. We will learn about the features of a mosque and the importance of pilgrimage to Muslims.

P.S.H.E.

In Jigsaw lessons, our focus will be relationships. We will have the opportunity to discuss friendships, stereotypes and reflect on the responsibilities of the members of our families. We will also look at the importance of keeping safe online.

P.E.

Topic 5

In P.E. this half term, we will be learning how to run at different speeds and for different durations of time. We will also be looking at using a racquet to hit and receive a ball using a forehand and backhand motion. Music In music this half term, we will explore disco music and the song "Brining Us Together". We will continue to use the glockenspiels and recorders, improvising and composing as a class. Computing

This half term, we will be focusing on programing in our computing sessions. We will be looking at the importance of sequencing and commands to produce an intended outcome.
