English – Reading and Writing

In reading, we will study the fiction text Polly Flint by Helen Cresswell, Tango Makes Three by Justin Richardson and will conclude with some performance poetry exploring Macavity The Mysterious Cat by T.S.Elliott.

In writing, we will be looking at the features of a journey narrative before we explore the writing devices used in creating a diary.

Maths

At the start of this topic, we will be exploring money as a measurement, including how to add and subtract amounts of money. We will then look at exploring the lengths and perimeters of 2D shapes. Following this, we will revisit a range of different methods of addition and subtraction.

Science

During our science lessons, we will be identifying and describing the functions of the parts of a plant. We will explore the life cycle of a flowering plant and look at how water is transported within a plant. We will also gain an understanding of how seeds are dispersed and the requirements of plants for life and growth.

History

This half term, we will be concluding our exploration of the prehistoric period by looking at the Iron Age. we will be learning how housing and farming changed during this period. We will also explore the art and culture of the period with a focus on Celtic knots and how they were used as a decorative source for jewelry and other artefacts.

Art and Design

In our art and design lessons, we will be looking at how Van Gogh used colour and paint techniques to create The Starry Night. We will recap our colour mixing techniques and extend our learning about bush techniques in order to apply these to our own pieces.

Computing

This half term, we will be focusing on programing in our computing sessions. We will be looking at the importance of sequencing and commands to produce an intended outcome.

R.E.

In R.E. this topic, we will be looking at Islam and explaining how Muslims worship. We will learn about the features of a mosque and the importance of pilgrima ge to Muslims.

P.S.H.E.

In Jigsaw lessons, our focus will be relationships. We will have the opportunity to discuss friendships, stereot ypes and reflect on the responsibilities of the members of our families. We will also look at the importance of keeping safe online.

P.E.

In P.E. this half term, we will be learning how to run at different speeds and for different durations of time. We will also be looking at using a racquet to hit and receive a ball using a forehand and backhand motion.
