

Speaking, Listening and Communication

We will be learning the British Sign Language signs for key nursery rhyme characters such as Humpty Dumpty and Incy, Wincy Spider. We will be listening to and joining in with different nursery rhymes.

English

In English, we will be reading nursery rhymes, including 'The Wheels on the Bus, Baa Baa Black Sheep and Humpty Dumpty'. We will look at different characters from the songs and notice rhyming words.

Maths

Through our maths learning, we will continue to sing counting songs and rhymes, using sign language for key words and counting on our fingers. We will also be counting and recognising numbers using nursery rhyme objects such as buses, spiders and sheep. We will start to learn 2-D shape names.

Physical Education

In our P.E. lessons, we will be practising different balances and climbing movements. We will also develop strength in our hands by threading, hole punching, dotting and cutting out different pictures.

P.S.H.E.

We will be noticing how characters in the nursery rhymes are feeling and answering questions such as "How does little Bo peep feel when she loses her sheep?" We will continue to develop our knowledge about the Zones of Regulation.

Scientific Technologies
